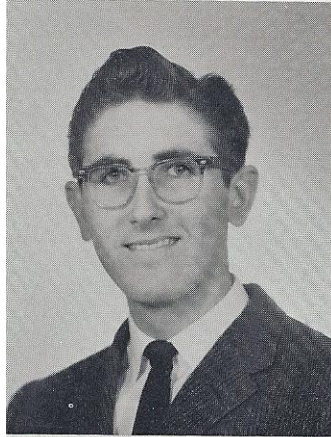


## DAVID C. SRNKA

NEWFIELD – David C. Srnka, 57, of 295 Piper Rd., Newfield, died unexpectedly on Sunday, July 9, 2000 at Geneva General Hospital after suffering a heart attack at his summer home on Seneca Lake while helping secure a neighbor's boat during a storm. Dave was born in Ithaca, son of Lottie Davenport Srnka and the late Charles Srnka.

Dave had been associated with Marion Electric for over thirty years and had owned the company since 1978. He served with the United States Navy during the Vietnam War. Dave was an avid golfer and outdoorsman and was a member of the Elks Lodge #636 and the Immaculate Conception Church.

In addition to his mother living in Ithaca, Dave is survived by his wife, Audrey Learn Srnka of Newfield; his sons, David M. (Elaine) Srnka of Dallas, Texas and Stephen K. Srnka of Ithaca; his brother and sister-in-law, Charles and Carol Srnka and their daughters, Tori and Carrie of Trumansburg and his grandchildren, Stephen Anthony Srnka, Miranda Lynn Srnka and a third grandchild whose birth Dave had been anxiously awaiting. He is also survived by aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews and cousins. In addition to his father, Dave was also predeceased by his sister, Susan Srnka. Dave will also be dearly missed by many friends and neighbors who he never hesitated to help in any way possible.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated by Rev. Leo Reinhardt on Thursday at 11 a.m. at the Immaculate Conception Church. Burial will follow in Calvary Cemetery.
