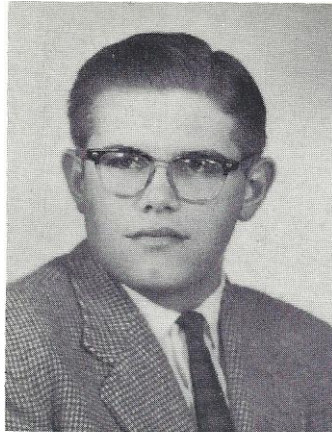

Mickey Trimberger, 66, died peacefully at home in Stallings, NC, on January 23rd, 2010, surrounded by family after a long, courageous battle with cancer and kidney failure.

Born in 1943 in Lincoln, Nebraska, Mickey grew up in Ithaca, where he graduated from Ithaca High School (1961), and received his BA (1965) and MBA (1967) from Cornell. Mickey played on both IHS and Cornell varsity football teams. He served as a First Lieutenant in the US Army from 1967 to 1969, with a year in Vietnam, where he was awarded the Bronze Star. After the Army, Mickey joined the DuPont Company, where he worked in marketing and sales for thirty-five years until his retirement in 2004. In his early years with DuPont, he met Diane Kennedy of Wilmington, Delaware, who became his loving wife of thirty-nine years.

Many knew Mickey as the ultimate family man, one who created an especially nurturing and loving family life. His sense of humor, warm manner and bountiful laugh won him friends everywhere.

In addition to Diane, his wife, Mickey is survived by a son, Michael (Vanessa) of Raleigh, NC; a daughter, Dr. Beth Benonis of Matthews, NC; a sister, Dr. E. Kay Trimberger of Berkeley, CA; a sister, Pamela Castro (Andrew) of Westtown, NY; three grandchildren and numerous nieces and nephews.
