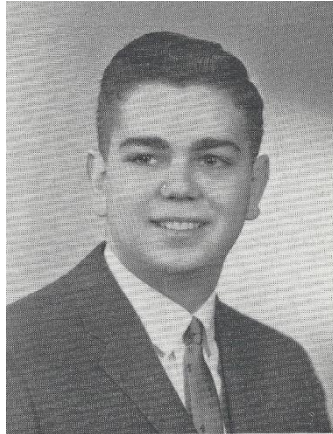

Tommy Yengo passed away at home on August 15, 2011. He suffered complications from an injury and had been in the hospital for nearly a month.
