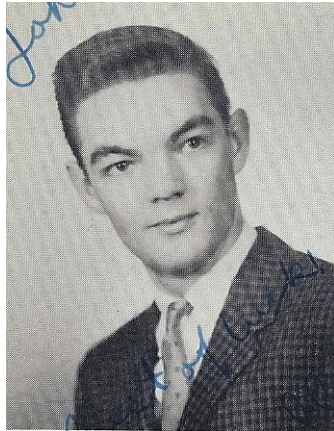

OBITUARY

LT. WILLIAM L. SULLIVAN

First Lt. William L. Sullivan, 27, son of Mr. and Mrs. Robert L. Sullivan of 212½ Delaware Ave. was killed in action Saturday, July 4, 1970, while on a combat mission with the 101st Airborne Division in Vietnam.

Lt. Sullivan was born in Oxford, Neb. Graduated from Ithaca High School, and attended Cornell University and the University of Nebraska before entering service.

He was graduated from the U.S. Army John F. Kennedy Center for Special Warfare (airborne) at Fort Bragg, N.C., and had been in Vietnam since February.

In addition to his parents, he is survived by his wife, Nancy J. Sullivan of Denver, Colo.: a brother, Robert M. Sullivan and three sisters, Melinda L., Jennifer S., and Judith A. Sullivan, all of Ithaca: paternal grandmother, Mrs. Louis W. Sullivan of Ithaca,: maternal grandmother, Mrs. Jennie Cowan of Oxford, Neb.: aunts, uncles, and cousins.
